



Project Brief:

Clubrooms Extension - this sports club had plans and aspirations, due to a growing membership, to extend their club rooms for a number of years. Having established the concrete slab to support the extension the project was floundering due to a lack of resources. Upon becoming aware of the existence of the Jobs Funded CIDG construction teams the Club requested assistance in completing their project.

The team set to work on the approved plans after recycled materials were sourced from a local school project under the **Building the Education Revolution** (BER), supplying doors, roofing materials and internal fittings along with timber milled by the local Natural Resource Group. The team recovered these materials thereby gaining valued demolition safety training whilst on the school site.

Work on this project will continue past the 'lock up' stage to allow the team members to enhance their building skills in the internal lining and fit out of the new club facility.
