



### Project Brief:

The Westbury Primary School approached the CIDG Project Manager with a request to develop and construct an outdoor educational facility, namely a large Gazebo.

The Project required the construction of an all weather facility capable of housing thirty students undercover within the school's central amenities area. The construction team have completed the erection of the requested facility.

During the two week construction timetable the team members developed skills that included carpentry (joinery), roofing and guttering, erection of and safe work practices associated with suspended scaffolding along with painting and finishing skills.
